

FIFTH GRADE SUPPLY LIST

To do all of the fifth grade work next year and to keep it organized, you will need:

- **BLUE** or **BLACK** ink pens – the choice is yours, but do **NOT** use purple, green, or red ink. I will not grade papers done in any color ink other than blue or black. The pens may be erasable or you may choose to have permanent ink pen and **White Out**. One more thing about pens: Do **NOT** use them for math! Math must be done in pencil.
- #2 pencils and erasers
- Pink, desk eraser
- a set of 6-8 colored **Crayola** pencils
- 7" scissors
- a roll of **Scotch** tape
- a glue stick
- a highlighter
- a small, inexpensive calculator
- a ruler (with metric and American measurements)
- a personal, manual pencil sharpener
- a flat, zippered pouch to hold your small items

You will also need:

- a large box of tissues
- a pack of wide-ruled notebook paper (We'll use a lot!)
- 7 spiral notebooks with pockets
- 1 folder with pockets
- It is strongly recommended that students bring their own Bibles to school so they can develop the habit of marking favorite verses studied in class. We use **The New Adventure Bible**

I am requesting that students bring small backpacks **without wheels** to fifth grade. I have lockers in my room to store our books and materials.

Do **NOT** purchase an assignment book or calendar. I will provide those on the first day of class.

Also, do **NOT** purchase a **Trapper Keeper** or other large notebook. They take up too much space. Students will organize their work in spiral notebooks.
