

Sunshine State Young Readers Frequently Asked Questions

When will the SSYRA books be available for checkout at the CCS library?

Beginning in October, all the SSYRA books will be available for checkout. There are 4 copies of each book available for checkout.

Where else could I find a SSYRA book?

SSYRA books are available at your local public library and bookstores.

How do students show they have read a SSYRA book?

Students have until **March 31** to read and complete a written book report or quiz on each book. Book reports are available in the library or on the school website.

When can students turn in book reports?

Before and after school, students can turn in book reports to Mrs. Mursell by visiting the school library or students may bring reports in during their weekly library class. Book reports can also be given to the classroom teacher to be sent down to the library.

How and when can students take a quiz on a SSYRA book?

Beginning in October, the SSYRA Program distributes the questions for each book. An announcement will be made during library class letting students know the quizzes are available. Students will have the opportunity to take a quiz during library class. Students may also come to the library afterschool with a parent to take a quiz.

Where can I get more information about the SSYRA program?

The SSYRA Book List and book report forms are available in the library. These documents can also be found on the school website in the *Library News*. For further questions and information please contact Gemma Mursell.

What will students earn for participating?

All students who participate and read one book from the list will receive a participation certificate. Students who read three or more books will qualify to vote in the statewide balloting for their favorite book. They will also receive a reading gift pack containing a bookmark, pencil, and other fun things. At the higher level of seven or more books read, students will be invited to attend a special luncheon in the library this spring. The top level will consist of those dedicated readers who read all 15 books. These students will receive a \$25.00 gift certificate to Barnes and Noble, and will be honored at Friday morning Chapel.
